

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS  
OF  
ADMISSION TO  
GERALD R. FORD AMPHITHEATER EVENTS**

The following are the terms and conditions of admission to events at the Gerald R. Ford Amphitheater. In consideration for the opportunity to attend an event, and by entering the premises, each entrant agrees to such terms and conditions, which apply regardless of the form of any ticket or other invitation to an event, or where or by whom such ticket or invitation is held, stored or displayed.

**RULES, INSTRUCTIONS AND DIRECTIONS:** The individual (“Attendee”) admitted to the Gerald R. Ford Amphitheater (“GRFA”), and any minor(s) accompanying Attendee, must follow all rules of the GRFA, and all posted and/or verbal directions and instructions of GRFA staff, while present on the GRFA premises. Failure to abide by such rules, instructions and directions may result in removal from the premises.

**MASK POLICY:** A face covering or mask is required to be worn at all times while on the GRFA premises, except as otherwise allowed in accordance with posted GRFA signage.

**COVID-19 WARNING:** An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, senior citizens and attendees with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable. By visiting the GRFA premises, Attendee voluntarily assumes all risks related to exposure to COVID-19.

**WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY; INDEMNIFICATION:** In exchange for admission to the GRFA premises, Attendee hereby forever and irrevocably releases and discharges Vail Valley Foundation; Town of Vail, Colorado; any individuals or entities associated in any capacity with the event or activities at the GRFA (including, without limitation, staff, officials, performers, sponsors, advertisers, promoters, suppliers, vendors and contractors); the parents, subsidiaries and affiliates of each of the foregoing; other GRFA event attendees; and all of their respective owners, directors, officers, volunteers, employees, agents, contractors, representatives and insurers; and the successors and assigns of each of them (each a “Releasee” herein), to the fullest extent permitted by law, from any and all liabilities, claims, demands, losses, damages, injuries (including injury, illness or death), costs or expenses (including, without limitation, reasonable attorneys’ fees and costs) (collectively, “Losses”) arising out of or in any way related to Attendee’s (or any accompanying minor’s) attendance at the GRFA premises; attendance at, observation of and/or participation in any event at the GRFA premises; or any related activities; including, without limitation, Losses related in any manner to COVID-19 or the negligence of any Releasee. In further exchange for admission to the GRFA premises, Attendee (i) covenants not to sue (or assist any person in suing) any Releasee regarding any matter released above, and (ii) agrees to indemnify and hold harmless any and all Releasees from and against any and all Losses related to any of the foregoing, or any acts or omissions of Attendee (or any accompanying minor(s)).

**MINOR ATTENDEES:** If Attendee is accompanied by any minor to the GRFA premises, by allowing the minor(s) to accompany attendee, Attendee makes and agrees to all the foregoing assumptions, releases, indemnifications and agreements on behalf of such minor(s). If Attendee does not wish to or is not authorized to make such assumptions, releases, indemnifications and other agreements on behalf of the accompanied minor(s), Attendee should not allow the minor to enter the GRFA premises.
